

Summary of VET Quality Framework audit information

As a Pre-qualified Supplier under the 2012–2015 Correctional Centre Training Initiative, Laundry Dry Cleaning Training is required to publish audit information in relation to its compliance with the VET Quality Framework.

The Correctional Centre Training Initiative provides public funding paid directly to Pre-qualified Suppliers for the delivery of appropriate vocational education (VE) and language, literacy and numeracy (LLN) training to prisoners in correctional and some Probation and Parole (P&P) centres across Queensland.

The VET Quality Framework is the national set of standards and conditions which assures nationally consistent, high-quality training and assessment services for the clients of Australia's vocational education and training system.

An audit of a registered training organisation reviews evidence of compliance with the requirements of the VET Quality Framework to confirm that it is achieving quality training and assessment outcomes. The process also identifies opportunities for improvement on these outcomes. Registered Training Organisation's that are awarded a VET Services Agreement for the Correctional Centre Training Initiative are required to publish the most recent audit conducted under the Australian Quality Training Framework (AQTF) or the VET Quality Framework.

This information is published to assist with decision making processes for the delivery of contracted VE and LLN training to prisoners.

Explanatory notes:

Non-compliance with the AQTF or VET Quality Framework means that requirements not been met based on the evidence reviewed. Non-compliances are categorised as minor, significant or critical. For the purposes of the Correctional Centre Training Initiative, only significant and Critical non-compliances need to be published.

Minor: No, or minor, adverse impact on learners with no serious breakdown of provision of quality training and assessment.

Significant: Significant adverse impact on learners with insufficient focus on quality training and assessment outcomes.

Critical: Critical adverse impact on learners with widespread or persistent dissatisfaction with services and outcomes.
